


CBS Redesign Implementation

WHAT ARE THE NEXT STEPS FOR SYSTEM CHANGE?

The Iowa HHS Transformation Plan is the next step for transforming the system statewide. The Transformation Plan references the Community-Based Services Evaluation guiding principles, presents strategies for community engagement, includes a framework for implementing recommendations (goals) and sub-recommendations (activities) from the Final Evaluation Report and describes the activities that Iowa HHS and its partners can begin in 2023.



HOW IS IMPLEMENTATION STRUCTURED?

Three work stream teams will support implementation.

- 1. The waitlist management team will help lowa HHS better identify needs for community-based services (CBS) and re-prioritize how people wait for Community-Based Services (CBS).
- 2. The waiver redesign team will help lowa HHS reimagine Medicaid home- and community-based services waivers so that people can stay in the community.

3. The case management team will support lowa HHS to improve how people find and learn about CBS.

Over time these teams may change to align with additional lowa HHS initiatives. We will provide updates on intersecting initiatives and new work streams.
