

I-TABS: Iowa's Technical Assistance and Behavior Supports

Providing technical assistance and behavior supports throughout Iowa to stakeholders who support Iowans who are Medicaid-eligible

Services Available:

- Consultation to stakeholders - discussion regarding existing Behavior Support Plans or behavioral practices which are not producing the desired outcome and potential alternative strategies
- Participation in Joint Treatment Planning or Member Centered Meeting calls
- Collaborate with various agencies to identify uses of Applied Behavior Analysis within treatment for the population(s) they support.
- Small group trainings on topics of value to stakeholders
- Other, as requests are received from stakeholders and/or service gaps are identified

Eligibility Criteria:

- At least one involved stakeholder (agency, group, service provider, volunteer) must be someone is supporting Iowans who are Medicaid-eligible.
- Specific attributes of the individual of focus (e.g. age, diagnoses, location of residency, etc.) do not determine eligibility.

Referrals:

- Anyone can make a referral; however, the recipient of the service must support the referral.

Cost of Services:

- Services provided by I-TABS are free-of-charge to stakeholders
