
BULLYING AT SCHOOL

42% of lesbian, gay & bisexual lowa public high school students were bullied on school property in 2019. This compares to **20**% of straight students.

SEXUAL VIOLENCE

27% of lesbian, gay, & bisexual lowa public high school students experienced sexual violence in the past year. This compares to 7% of straight students.





VAPING

1 in 3 lesbian, gay, & bisexual Iowa public high school students were currently using an electronic vaping product in 2019. This compares to 1 in 5 straight students.





63% of lesbian, gay, & bisexual lowa public high school students experienced persistent feelings of sadness or hopelessness. This compares to 28% of straight students.

SUICIDE IDEATION

Nearly half of lesbian, gay, & bisexual lowa public high school students seriously considered suicide in 2019. This compares to 15% of straight students.

SUICIDE ATTEMPTS

22% of lesbian, gay, & bisexual lowa public high school students attempted suicide in the previous year. This compares to 7% of straight students.

In 2019, 13% of Iowa high school students identified as gay, lesbian or bisexual.5% were unsure of their sexual orientation.
