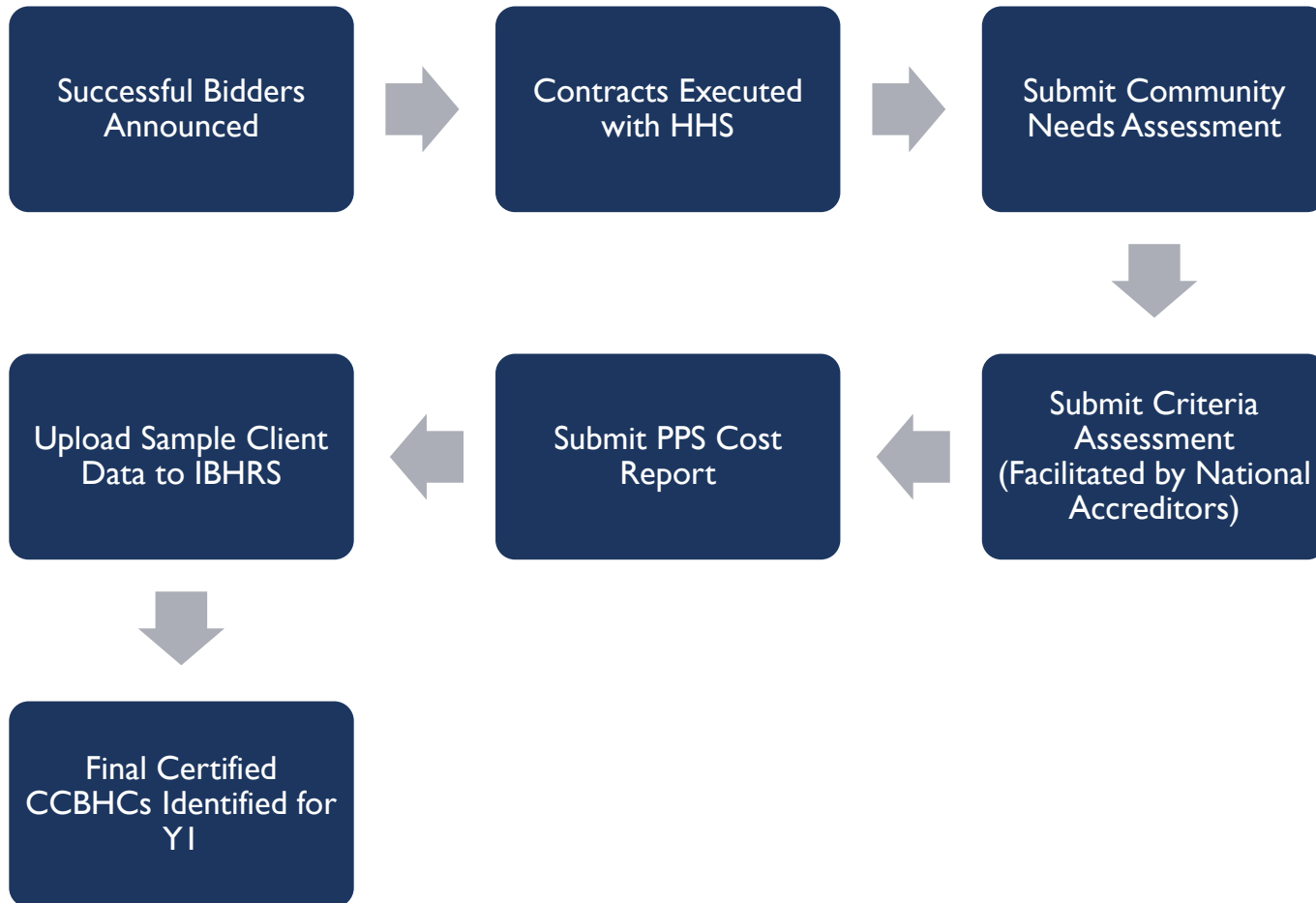

- There will also be 1:1 TA support available to successful bidders

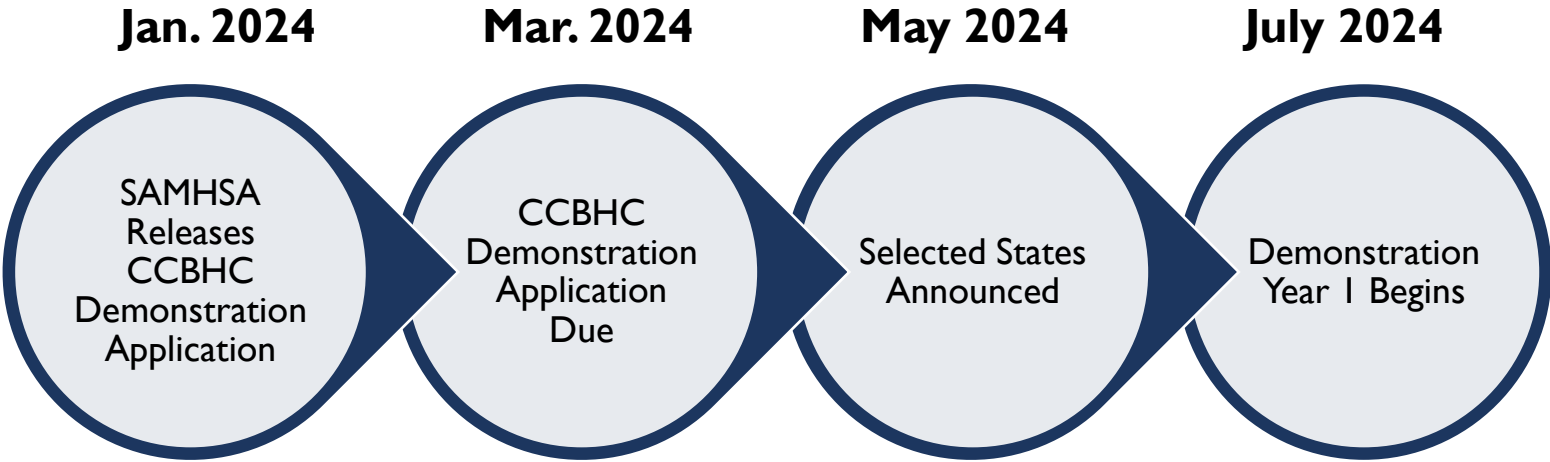

# The goals of the CCBHC initiative

- One critical question is about Iowa's specific goals for the initiative
- HHS will (likely) need to select from four goals offered by SAMHSA
- For each goal we select we will need to speak to:
  - The process we used to select the goal
  - The specific measures we will monitor during the demonstration to ascertain the impact on the goal
  - Baseline data for goal-related measures so we know from where we're starting
  - Plan to collect and analyze the data for each goal
  - Projected impact on the identified measures

# Goal 1 SAMHSA offered last time

- Provide the most complete scope of services required in the CCBHC Criteria to individuals who are eligible for medical assistance under the State Medicaid program
- Address the gaps in the Medicaid-funded BH service continuum in Iowa

## Goal 2 SAMHSA offered last time

- Improve availability of, access to, and participation in, services described in subsection (a) (2) (D) to individuals eligible for medical assistance under the State Medicaid program;
- Improve access to the nine CCBHC services for Medicaid recipients in Iowa



# Goal 3 SAMHSA offered last time

- Improve availability of, access to, and participation in assisted outpatient mental health treatment in the State;
- Increase the number of Iowans receiving outpatient treatment under a court order

# Goal 4 SAMHSA offered last time

- Demonstrate the potential to expand available mental health services in a demonstration area and increase quality of such services without increasing net Federal spending.
- Improve BH service volume and quality without increasing federal spending
