Home Health/Durable Medical Equipment, additional points

Health Home

- Nursing services (5 visits per week) Medication support, Medical education and Monitoring, PT, OT, Medical Social Services.
- Physician certification of plan every 60 days.

DME

- Walker, wheelchairs, Breastpump, CPaP Machine, Shower chair, Hi-Lo Hospital beds/semi electric, Dialysis equipment, Helmets.
- Durable medical equipment, supplies, and prosthetic devices must be necessary due to the members medical condition. An item is necessary when it is expected to make a meaningful improvement or contribution in a members life.

- Vision
 - Optometrist (eye doctor)
 - Eye exams
 - Optician (fitting glasses, contacts)
 - Glasses, contacts
- Hearing
 - Audiologist services
 - Audiological Testing, Hearing exams one per year
 - Cerumen (Earwax) Removal
 - Newborn and Infant Hearing Screening
 - Vestibular Testing
 - Hearing Assistance service
 - Devices, repairs, replacement

- Dental
 - Preventative services
 - Oral Prophylaxis
 - Fluoride
 - Dental Sealants
 - Oral Evaluations
 - Comprehensive
 - Periodic
 - Limited

 - .30/mile for eligible Medicaid members

- lowa Finance Authority(IFA) project based Branch of section 8 helping pay partial rent and is involved in over 9,000 units. Apply by calling IFA
- Iowa Making homes affordable options.
 - Homeowner program
- Iowa Homeless service organizations
 - Emergency solution grant, shelter assistance fund(helps keep shelters going)
- Demographics
 - Veterans, Pregnant Women & Kids, Homeless

- Clothing
 - Clothing closets throughout the state, Thrift stores, Vouchers (Community Action)
- Food
 - Food pantries, churches, Food Bank of Iowa, SNAP
- Maternity/Newborn Items
 - WIC, Nine2Thrive, Iowa family support network
- School Supplies/physicals for low income or uninsured
 - School Supplies drives private non profits/business', Supply drive through the school districts(usually end of July early august), Churches also help provide.

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Members Transitioning out of Medicaid

- Loss of eligibility due to income
- Loss of eligibility due to age/transition into adulthood.
 - Affordable care act MarketPlace/Healthcare.gov
- Above 65? Apply for Medicare
- 30-day appeal if needed for redetermination
- If a member is losing Medicaid, the IHH should help plan and prepare while this member is still in their care.
 - Applying for medically necessary, new insurance coverage, possibly helping find providers that will cover their new insurance so there is no lapse in mental health, physical treatment or medication.
