Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for tobacco cessatio theck all that apply:

 \Box This policy includes the grounds of the center/home.

 \Box This policy applies to all enclosed areas of the center/home.

□ This requirement extends to all persons, including employees, and visitors.

 \Box This policy applies at all times.

 \Box This policy applies to vehicles operated by the center/home.

□ This policy applies to employee vehicles while at work and to any vehicle used to transport children.

 \Box Providers/teachers/staff are prohibited from wearing clothing that smells of smoke when working.

Persons failing to abide by this policy are required to extinguish their smoking material,

dispose of the tobacco/nicotine product or leave the premises immediately.
