
IBHRS Data Model

Service Event Data Set: Overview and Requirements

- A **Service Event** record represents a specific treatment encounter for a client with a substance use, problem gambling, or other disorder, in a provider site as part of their treatment program.
- A **Service Event** record may contain a **Procedure Modifier** records that further describe a Service Event record's **Procedure Code**.
- A **Service Event** record includes **Service Event Care Status** records that associate the **Service Event** to applicable **Care Status** records within the same **Treatment Episode**.






Associating Service Events with Care Statuses




- In this example we start with a Treatment Episode with four Care Status records.
- The Treatment Episode Identifier is TX999
- The Care Status Identifiers are CS101, CS102, CS103

Associating Service Events with Care Statuses



- Here we have associated a Service Event record with the Treatment Episode
- The Service Event (orange) indicates that a **Service** was provided to the **Client** during this Treatment Episode.
- The Care Status within the Service Event (green) indicates in **which Care Status** the Service was provided.
- For example: An “Individual” service was provided as part of the Admission to Gambling Treatment.



- In this example, a **second** Service Event is associated with this Episode.
- As an example, this Service Event could be counseling that was provided as part of **both** SUD and Problem Gambling treatment.
- This Service Event is associated with Care Statuses 101 and 101.

Service Event Data Set Rules

Rule Type	Rule Name	Message
Error	Only Providers With Active Contract Types Can Submit IDPH Procedures Rule	A Service Event with a Procedure Source Code of Iowa Department of Public Health (i.e. 12200.2 can only be submitted when a Provider Contract Type exists where the Service Date is within the Provider Contract Type's Start Date and End Date.

- **Procedure Source Code:** The source of the Procedure Code, e.g. CPT4, HCPCS or IDPH
- **Provider Contract Type:** A sub-entity of Provider that defines a Contract with a Start and End date.
 - **Examples:** IPN, Women and Children



- **Rule:** A Service Event with a **Procedure Code** that is associated to a particular **Special Initiative(s)** must have at least one corresponding Special Initiative where the Service Date falls within the Special Initiative Start Date and End Date.

Service Event Data Set Rules

- **Rule:** A Service Event with a Procedure Code that is associated to a particular Special Initiative(s) **must have** at least one corresponding Special Initiative where the Service Date falls within the Special Initiative Start Date and End Date.
 - “**must have**” means “Must be associated to a Treatment Episode that contains”



Service Event Data Set Rules

- **Rule:** A **Service Event** with a **Procedure Code** that is associated to a particular **Modifier Category** must have at least one corresponding **Service Event Procedure Modifier** where the **Modifier Code** is associated to that same **Modifier Category**.
