- Problem Gambling Treatment Services
  - Treatment services are intended to support lowa residents who are not eligible for Medicaid, do not have insurance, and do not have access to other resources to pay for needed Covered Services.





- Problem Gambling Treatment Services
  - Contractors must apply all available funding from third party payors prior to determining a patient's eligibility for contract funding and must assure services are paid by the correct payor.





- Problem Gambling Treatment Services
  - Iowa residents who meet the requirements are eligible to receive treatment Licensed Program Services for Patients and Other Covered Services for Patients and may receive such services from the contractor(s) of their choice.



# ELIGIBILITY

- Income at or below 200% of the Federal poverty guidelines as published by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, and
- Not insured, or third party payment is not available to pay for the services.
  - Contract funding can pay for Licensed Program Services that are not covered during the gap period between enrollment in Medicaid and assignment to a managed care organization because of Medicaid (b) (3) services requirements.
  - Contract funding can pay for substance use disorder residential Licensed Program Services for Patients that are not covered services under the Iowa Health and Wellness Plan.

#### Outpatient Services

Different Unit Rates for Certified/Licensed and Independently Licensed staff for Outpatient Services

- Assessment
  - 1 per episode
- Individual Counseling
  - Family
  - Financial (required by Iowa Code)
- Group Counseling

NOTE: Individual and Group Counseling Encounter Duration – Round to nearest 30 minutes.



#### Outpatient Services

#### New Service for IPN - Problem Gambling Treatment

- Intensive Outpatient/Partial Hospitalization
  - Encounter Type = 24 Hour service
  - Duration Type = Min (Days is not an option in the Gambling domain)
  - Min = 1



### Other Covered Services

- Care Coordination
  - At least 1 billed service per month to receive monthly rate.
- Medical Evaluation
  - Telehealth Option
  - 1 per patient per episode of care
- Medical Care
  - Telehealth Option
- Medication
  - Limited to \$100 per month (\$300 max per treatment episode)



### Other Covered Services

- Recovery Peer Coaching
- Transportation
  - Limited to \$20 per month, \$60 per

treatment episode



The Licensure Standards define Early Intervention as "the ASAM criteria level of care which explores and addresses problems or risk factors that appear to be related to an addictive disorder and which helps the individual recognize potential harmful consequences."



- May be provided to persons who have received an Initial Assessment and meet criteria for a gambling disorder but who are unwilling to be admitted to recommended treatment.
- May be provided to lowa residents at risk for a substance use disorder or problem gambling.
- May be provided to family members or friends of patients of persons with gambling problems who are not in treatment.



- Includes counseling persons in crisis.
  - Counseling persons in crisis can be in person or over the phone.
  - Includes Your Life Iowa/1-800-BETS OFF
    "warm-hand-offs"
    - 24/7/365 access to problem gambling treatment professional
    - YLI Warm Handoff Orientation
      - February 26, 2019 2 PM



## • Tracking

- Patient Information Collected to create client profile in I-SMART:
  - Event Type = Crisis
  - Encounter Type = Individual/Group/Family note
  - Duration Type = Min
  - Duration = round to nearest 30 minute increment.
- Patient not identified
  - Track internally per agency policy/procedure.

#### INTEGRATED CARE

Through the Integrated Provider Network, contractors assist IDPH to protect and improve the health of Iowans by meeting the following three goals:

- Establish and maintain a comprehensive and effective system of care for substance use and gambling problems through a statewide, integrated network of services and providers.
- Reduce substance use and gambling problems through public education, evidence-based prevention, and early intervention services.
- Increase remission and recovery from substance use disorders and problem gambling through timely, accessible, ongoing, and effective treatment services.

#### INTEGRATED CARE

- High comorbidity between mental health, substance use disorders, cigarette use with those experiencing symptoms of a gambling disorder
  - Important to screen for Mental Health and Substance Use Disorders
  - Patients may receive SUD and PG Services in same treatment episode, just can't bill both for same service (separate budgets within contract)
