COMES NOW the Iowa Department of Public Health (“Department”) and Wayne D. Koehler (“Respondent”), and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4), enter into the following Consent Agreement:

1. The Respondent is certified as an Emergency Medical Technician and holds certification number EMT-08-1005-71.
2. Respondent suffers from a medical condition which impairs or limits his ability to provide emergency medical services.
3. The Department has jurisdiction over parties and subject matter of this action.
4. Execution of this Consent Agreement constitutes the resolution of this case. Respondent has a right to a hearing, but waives his right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to appeal, by freely and voluntarily agreeing to this Consent Agreement. Once entered, this Order shall have the force and effect of a disciplinary order entered following contested case hearing.
5. This Consent Agreement is a public record available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapter 22.

6. In the event the Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms or provisions of this Agreement, the Department may initiate the appropriate action to revoke or suspend Respondent's certification or to impose other appropriate discipline.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

7. The Respondent agrees to indefinitely restrict his practice as an Emergency Medical Technician to providing dispatch, education or instruction services. Respondent agrees that he shall not perform any clinical functions of an Emergency Medical Technician which exceed the permanent restrictions imposed by his physician.
