Community Partnership Grant Funding Available

a) Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 641 - 151.7 (142A) Distribution of Funding establishes the following formula for determining Community Partnership grant funding available to each county:

Rural Counties:

\$.84 per school-age youth plus an additional \$.84 per non-school-age county resident

Metropolitan statistical areas (as defined by the U.S. Bureau of Census)

\$.52 per school-age youth plus an additional \$.52 per non-school-age county resident

- b) The total funding available for a multiple-county Community Partnership application is the combined total of funding available to each county included in the application.
- c) No county shall be allocated less than \$10,000 base funding.
