RE: "CC" and "KR" Modifiers

EFFECTIVE: May 1, 2013

Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) modifiers "CC" and "KR" have been added to the Medicaid claims payment system to help expedite processing of claims for some medical equipment and supply items.

- Modifier "CC" should be billed when the quantity of a supply provided differs from that
 in the HCPCS definition. Example: One unit of blood glucose test strips, procedure
 code A4253, is defined in HCPCS as 50 strips. If a member was provided with 25
 strips, A4253 with the CC" modifier should be billed. The number of units would be 25
 for the actual quantity provided.
- Modifier "KR" should be billed for equipment rental when the rental period is less than
 one month. Example: A standard wheelchair, procedure code K0001, was rented for
 six weeks. The first month would be billed as K0001-RR with one unit for the month.
 The remaining two weeks would be billed with K0001-RR and KR with 14 units for the
 14 days.

The procedure code lists for which these modifiers should be used are found at: http://www.ime.state.ia.us/Providers/CSRP.html. **Note**: With the exception of some wheelchairs, equipment for which the monthly rental fee is less than \$150 per month are generally excluded from the list, as are some items that are rarely used for less than a full month.
