

Income and Resource Eligibility Criteria for Common Non-MAGI Programs

SSI Medicaid

For elderly disabled individuals with income below the SSI income standard.

Medicaid Savings Programs

For people with Medicare Part A and Part B with limited income and resources.

Medicaid for Kids with Special Needs (MKSN)

For people with a disability who are under 18.

Medical for Employed People with Disabilities (MEPD)

For people with a disability under age 65 that are employed.
