What is SafeCare?

SafeCare is an evidence-based parenting training program for parents and/or caregivers of children ages 0-5.

Your SafeCare consultant has participated in specialized training and a certification process.

- The SafeCare visits are typically conducted in weekly home visits lasting about one hour per visit over approximately 18 weeks.
- There will be sessions where the SafeCare provider might work with just you and other sessions where your child(ren) will join.
- SafeCare providers work with your family in the home to improve skills in three areas- Safety, Health, and Parent-Child and Parent-Infant Interactions.
