## Waiver Redesign Structure and Eligibility

Over the past two years, Iowa Health and Human Services (HHS) has gathered input from Iowans to help it redesign its home and community-based services waivers to better meet the needs of Iowans with disabilities.



**ELIGIBILITY & ENROLLMENT** | To be eligible, individuals must meet two criteria: (1) they need the level of care that would be provided in an institution, and (2) their disability fits into one of the categories below.
