Trauma Informed Care (TIC)

- Trauma: reaction or response to an event, action, or circumstance(s)
 - Individual
 - Family
 - Group
 - Community
 - Cultural, Racial, Historical
 - Mass
- Correlation between trauma and both physical and mental health
- Impacts of trauma can be both immediate and/or recurrent
 - Result in emotional, physical, psychological, behavioral, developmental, and other symptoms
- TIC is an evidence-based practice proven to support healing, coping, and building emotional resilience
 - TIC “**realizes** the widespread impact of trauma and understands potential paths for recovery; **recognizes** the signs and symptoms of trauma in clients, families, staff, and others involved with the system; and **responds** by fully integrating knowledge about trauma into policies, procedures, and practices, and seeks to actively **resist** re-traumatization”
