

Community Partnership Grant Funding Available

a) Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 641 - 151.7 (142A) Distribution of Funding establishes the following formula for determining Community Partnership grant funding available to each county:

Rural Counties:

\$.84 per school-age youth plus an additional \$.84 per non-school-age county resident

Metropolitan statistical areas (as defined by the U.S. Bureau of Census)

\$.52 per school-age youth plus an additional \$.52 per non-school-age county resident

****The counties that are in bold print and have an asterik by the are counties that are considered a Metropolitan Statistical Area as defined by Office of Management and Budget**

b) The total funding available for a multiple-county Community Partnership application is the combined total of funding available to each county included in the application.

c) No county shall be allocated less than \$10,000 base funding.

The following allocation tables detail Community Partnership grant funding that may be applied for by each county based upon 2021 population estimates. It also shows how many goal areas are required for each county.
