

HCBS Waiver Program

Iowa Medicaid's HCBS waiver program currently has seven waivers:



In Progress Solutions



Looking at additional service options as a part of the Community-Based Services (CBS) Redesign.



Invest in remote monitoring for members.



Offer respite to spouses or family members who are caregivers to their loved ones.



Continue some of the expanded services made available during the public health emergency (PHE).




\$100 million made available in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) dollars to help strengthen the workforce.


ARPA & CBS Redesign

ARPA

- lowa has invested more than \$125M in state only funds in ARPA grant to support improved quality and expanded access to HCBS.
- The focus of the grants is specific to three areas:
 - Increasing training & support
 - Expanding access to services
 - Workforce support

The Community-Based Services Redesign Project

In 2022, Iowa Medicaid partnered with researchers from Mathematica and the Harkin Institute to complete an evaluation on Iowa Medicaid's Community-Based Services (CBS), which includes Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS), to find out how Iowans could better access the services.
