Meeting Minutes (Q1 2024)

Silent roll call proceeded & Committee Member quorum was confirmed.

Introduction: Heidi Weaver, Project Manager, IME QIO welcomed everyone to the first quarterly 2024 Iowa Medicaid Clinical Advisory Committee (CAC) Meeting with an overview of the house rules.

Announcements: Heidi Weaver introduced her new role as the Facilitator of the meeting, then introduced the Committee Chairman, Dr. Jagiello, who is the Medical Director for IME QIO.

She provided instructions for the Public Comment presentations, with the use of a new visible timer for each Public Guest Speaker and allotment of 5 minutes to present. She also provided the new CAC email available for any correspondence at CAC@dhs.state.ia.us.

She introduced roll call voting, as it will be used for the method of capturing all committee members' individual votes.

Approval of the October 20, 2023 Minutes: there were no comments or change requests.

Dr. Jagiello opened for a vote:

First motion to approve by Dr. Ferguson. Second motion to approve by Dr. Danley.

Five of eight Committee Members were present and voted to approve.

Dr. Jagiello welcomed new Committee Member, Dr. Geetanjali Sahu, Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist. Dr. Sahu provided a brief introduction of herself.

Old Business: Heidi Weaver announced the next order of business is the review of Old Business.

I. Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM)

Dr. Jagiello presented the criteria review and explained the changes that have taken place during the previous three quarterly CAC meetings: 1. Elimination to test 4x/day and 2. changed criteria section a from 3 or more, to “multiple times daily”, section d simplified language implemented & type I for 18 years or younger (included), and new criteria articulated to include gestational diabetes or diabetes during pregnancy. He opened the meeting for Public Comments or concerns regarding the new criteria:

1. *Roy Thomas, PharmD, Director, Medical Science, Managed Markets, presented comments.*
2. *Marie Frazzitta, DNP, FNP-c, PNP, MBA, CDCES, Abbott, presented comments.*
3. *Emily Beckett, PharmD, BCPS, Broadlawns Medical Center, presented comments.*

Dr. Jagiello updated the criteria language as an administrative call to address Dr. Becketts comments to clarify section 1.a to add language for “(2 or more doses) daily”.

4. *Wendy Mobley-Bukstein, PharmD, BCACP, CDCES, CHWC, FAPhA, Drake University, Primary Health Care Clinic, presented comments.*
5. *Dr. Krishnan-Medical Director, Wellpoint- (formerly Amerigroup), presented comments regarding pediatrics and during pregnancy and had a few follow-up questions. Emily Beckett provided comment to her questions. Dr. Mobley-Bukstein also provided comments to her questions.*
6. *Dr. Reddy, Endocrinologist, and Committee Member provided comments regarding CGM use for gestational diabetic patients, and it how it has completely changed patient care, with ability to see real time data, and creates active patient participation in their own care.*

Dr. Jagiello addressed Dr. Danley’s email that was sent out to the Committee for review prior to the meeting.

Dr. Danley provided comments on the two changes she’d still like to see: Section 1- remove “multiple times a day” and that it “doesn’t need to be basal once a day”, due to other medications for other medical reasons and the goal to not have patients need to be on insulin, and the CGM helps so much to control their sugars. She would take out “insulin” within the gestational criteria.

Dr. Jagiello provided a summary of Nicole Cortis, RN, BSN, Perinatal Diabetic Educators’ written comments which had been submitted in advance of the meeting, since she was unable to attend in person.

Dr. Jagiello opened the criteria for comments and discussion by the Committee: Dr. Ferguson commented the discussion on gestation diabetes has been very compelling, and not using one isn’t practical, and defers to the experts in the field, and that it should be more liberal than what it is allowed currently. This seems to be the more cost effective and safest way to go, and appreciates the criteria updates, and points to the good data available and that its showing CGM use offers better care.

Dr. Reddy commented on changes to the criteria language in section 2. A to remove “insulin multiple times daily”. Dr. Jagiello revised the criteria to strike out 2.a. Dr. Danley commented she agrees with the change.

Marie Frazzita made an additional comment from the public, to align to raise awareness for guidelines around “patient choice” that both the Dexcom and the Freestyle Libre are approved for pregnancy.

Dr. Sahu, Committee Member, commented in support of Dr. Danley’s comments on in general they try to avoid giving insulin multiple times and they try to use other drug therapies and supports removing 1.a. Dr. Reddy, supports this change. Dr. Jagiello revised the criteria to strike 1.a-language of “multiple times (2 or more doses)”.

Dr. Jagiello provided the following comments regarding the role of this committee, as the recommending body to draft policies for submission to Iowa Medicaid for the final decision. Iowa Medicaid has the right to complete a fiscal analysis regarding the changes and make a decision to accept or reject the Committee’s recommendations. At this point in time, there is a modified draft criteria with changes to 1a and 2a.

Consent Agenda: Heidi Weaver announced the next order of business was the Consent Agenda.
Dr. Jagiello provided the purpose of the Consent Agenda, then opened for public comments.

Public comments:

1. *Deb Brugman, Foundation Medicine- shared comments on item 12-Molecular Analysis for Targeted Therapy of Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer. Item has been brought back due to request to broaden the criteria so it's closer aligned with CMS, national coverage decision guidance, National Comprehensive Cancer Network (NCCN), American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO), and additional publications. She asked that the Committee re-evaluate the current criteria due to growing evidence and testing changes. She advised the importance of this to the Medicaid beneficiary populations. She'd like to see a change to the panel size under Medically Necessary (2.) to expand to larger than 50 gene panels.*
2. *Queentela Benjamin, Foundation Medicine- on item 12-Molecular Analysis for Targeted Therapy of Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer shared comments in conjunction with the prior commenter. They request Iowa Medicaid to consider covering FoundationOne CDx, which would be in alignment with Medicare criteria. There are now 16 Medicaid programs that cover FoundationOne CDx, so they are working to address the gap, with the inequities and access to CGPs, so that Medicaid members can have access to this test, to align with coverage for commercially insured members and Medicare members.*

Dr. Jagiello indicated that a Committee Member would need to make a motion to remove the criteria from the Consent Agenda and send it back for reconsideration at the April CAC meeting to look at any new evidence submitted and/or another literature review.

Dr. Ferguson, Committee Member, motioned in the first, to modify the criteria for item 12, Molecular Analysis for Targeted Therapy of Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer, due to the importance to review further data, since in her primary work experience there is growing evidence in the increased number of genes being used and identifying factors. Motion in the second by Dr. Zachary.

Dr. Jagiello opened for a vote to remove from the consent agenda and bring it back for full consideration in April: All approved to table it at this time.

Heidi Weaver gave the continued opportunity for registered public presenters to speak on Consent Agenda items:

1. *Brian Howell, Regional Medical Director, Novartis, offered public comment for Zolgensma. They are in support of this criteria and the continued importance of this therapy utilization without obstacles to prevent delayed care.*

Dr. Jagiello expressed appreciation for the public comments and that it will remain on the Consent Agenda and will be looked at again in a year.

Dr. Ferguson offered additional comments on a few items, including Bariatric Surgery criteria and the new changes to consider.

Dr. Jagiello offered the opportunity to vote on the current Consent Agenda on an *As-is Approval*, since they are his personal agenda for updates and to bring back to the April 2024 meeting for updates.

Dr. Ferguson, Committee Member, offered a correction for a typo in the Liver Transplant criteria, that should state CD4, instead of D4 and emailed the request for correction. She inquired on Orphan Drugs, on why only 3 are listed as covered, and asked if it's an all-inclusive list, and if an active search is done each year to determine if new Orphan Drugs have come on board.

Dr. Umbreit provided clarification that it's not an all-inclusive list. There are several other individual policies that have Orphan Drug utilization, the 3 that are listed are the ones with low utilization.

There were no further questions or comments on the Consent Agenda.

There were updates for two Surgical Procedures:

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I. Lung Transplant-Dr. Jagiello presented the criteria changes, as recommended by the specialty review, consistent with the National Organ Transplant Guidelines, shown below:

Relative Contraindications

1. Relative age limit which can span from 65-75.
2. Severe or symptomatic osteoporosis.
3. Class I obesity with a BMI of 30-35.
4. Severe or progressive malnutrition.
5. Extensive prior thoracic surgery with lung resection.
6. Various high resistant infectious agents such as Aspergillus, Scedosporium, nontuberculous bacterium, multidrug-resistant bacteria, Burkholderia species.
7. HIV infection with a detectable viral load.
