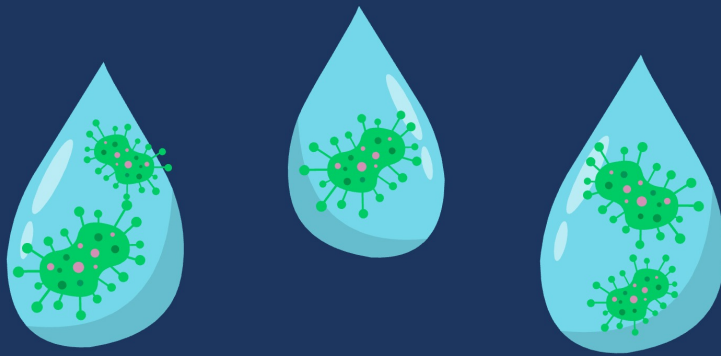


Respiratory Droplets



- Some germs spread through respiratory droplets - tiny drops of water in our breath
- Sick people breathe out germs when they do things like cough, talk, sing, or sneeze

People spread germ-carrying droplets by...

- Breathing out droplets which are breathed in by other people
- Breathing out droplets which land on surfaces leaving germs behind
- Getting droplets on their hands then touching surfaces leaving germs behind



Healthy people pick up germ-carrying droplets by...



- Breathing in germ-carrying droplets
- Touching surfaces where germ-carrying droplets land then touching their eyes, mouth, or nose
