


Council on Health and Human Services TENTATIVE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES ADOPTION SCHEDULE

Administrative rule chapters on this document were reviewed by the Council on Health and Human Services (HHS) as Notice of Intended Action documents. These administrative rule chapters are planned to be on Council on HHS agendas for adoption (voting), as outlined below. Adopted filing documents sent as part of the Council on HHS agenda will indicate whether public comments have been received and whether changes have been made to the rule text since Council on HHS's previous review. A summary of the rulemaking process is included below.
