### Senate File 2385

Consolidation of Hawki and MAAC



#### Overview

The Hawki (Healthy and Well Kids of Iowa) Board will be consolidated into MAAC, and MAAC will take on Hawki's duties.

- The bill is a part of Gov. Reynold's initiative to eliminate unnecessary and redundant boards and commissions.
- The bill, once signed, becomes effective July 1, 2024.

# Highlights of Final Rule

- Creation of a Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC)
  - Current or former Medicaid beneficiaries
  - Those with direct experience supporting Medicaid beneficiaries; e.g., family members, caregivers, etc.
- ► That a percentage of MAAC members are from BAC
  - 2025-2026 10%
  - 2026-2027 20%
  - 2027 25%
- BAC must meet separately from MAAC
- Annual MAAC Report

## Highlights of Final Rule Continued

- The Iowa Medicaid team is completing a review of all the final rule provisions and impacts to the Medicaid and CHIP programs.
- Implementation for this section of the rules is July 1, 2025, with additional requirements for transition effective July 2027.
- In the coming weeks, analysis will be completed on the specific section of the regulation for the new MAC and BAC requirements.
- Consideration will be given to current State Law and administrative rules for MAAC.
- Updates will be provided on the analysis and impacts identified at the MAAC at future MAAC meetings.
