SUSPENSION/CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code Sections 17A.18, 147A.7, and Iowa Administrative Code (I.A.C.) 641—131.7, the Iowa Department of Public Health is proposing to indefinitely **SUSPEND** your EMS certification identified above and levy a **CIVIL PENALTY** against you in the amount of \$50.00.

The Department may suspend and levy a civil penalty on an EMS provider when it finds that the certificate holder has committed any of the following acts or offenses:

Failure to comply with the terms of a department order or the terms of a settlement agreement or settlement order. IAC 641—131.7(3)d

Failure to respond within 30 days of receipt, unless otherwise specified, of communication from the department which was sent by registered or certified mail. *IAC* 641—131.7(3)ab

The following events have lead to this notice:

On April 15, 2009, the Department placed your certification on probation through October 27, 2012. As a condition of your probation, you are required to submit probation reports due on the tenth of April, July, October and January. The Department previously sent you a letter concerning late probation reports for the period of September through December 2010. You did provide the requested report, however the letter advised you that failure to provide future reports could lead to revocation or suspension of your certification.

You have failed to file three reports with the Department covering the periods of October through December of 2011 and January through June of 2012.

Your certification shall be suspended until the following is received, processed and approved by the Department:

- 1) Probation reports covering the period of October 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.
- 2) \$50 civil penalty

You have the right to request a hearing concerning this notice of disciplinary action. A request for a hearing must be submitted in writing to the Department by certified mail, return receipt requested, within twenty (20) days of receipt of this Notice of Proposed Action. The written request must be submitted to the Iowa Department of Public Health, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, Lucas State Office Building, 321 East 12th Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50319. If the request is made within the twenty (20) day time limit, the proposed action is suspended pending the outcome of the hearing. Prior to, or at the hearing, the Department may rescind the notice upon satisfaction that the reason for the action has been or will be removed.

If no request for a hearing is received within the twenty (20) day time period, the disciplinary action proposed herein shall become effective and shall be final agency action.
