#### How can I submit an application to become a child care provider?

Provider Applications can be submitted:

- Online through the Child Care Provider Portal <u>https://ccmis.dhs.state.ia.us/providerportal/default.aspx</u>
- Contact your local Iowa CCR&R agency to pick up an application or have one mailed to you
- Print the PDF form, complete in ink, and email to crsacca@dhs.state.ia.us
- Print the PDF form, complete in ink, and fax to 515-564-4012

#### How can I report changes for my registration?

Report changes in address, household composition, substitutes or assistants to the CCA Registration Unit by filling out an application on the Child Care Provider Portal. If you have questions on the type of changes to report, call 1-866-448-4605 or email <u>crsacca@dhs.state.ia.us</u> within 10 days of the change.

Report changes in rates by completing and submitting a new Provider Agreement form (470-3871). Provider Agreements can be submitted online through the Child Care Provider Portal or printed and emailed to <u>crsacca@dhs.state.ia.us</u>.

#### Can I submit my renewal for my registration online?

Yes, there are two options to submit your registration renewal online:

- Go online to the Child Care Provider Portal and submit your renewal application within 90 days prior to your registration ending
- Scan and email a paper copy of your renewal application to <u>crsacca@dhs.state.ia.us</u> within 90 days prior to your registration ending
