The Agency further reserves the right to cancel the notice at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.

Applicants not listed above will not be awarded a contract pursuant to the above referenced RFP. The posting of this notice of intent to award constitutes receipt of the adverse decision.

Applicants may appeal the adverse decision by filing a written appeal within 10 business days of posting of the Notice of Intent to Award in accordance with RFP Section 1.30. An appeal shall be addressed to the contract compliance officer cited in the RFP, Iowa Department of Health and Human Services, and shall be submitted in writing via email, including a read receipt verification to [john.mcmullen@hhs.iowa.gov](mailto:john.mcmullen@hhs.iowa.gov). Appeals must clearly and fully identify all issues being contested and demonstrate what procedures in the RFP were not followed by the

Agency. In the event of an appeal, the Agency will continue working with the successful applicant(s) pending the outcome of the appeal.
