JUSTIFICATION OF VARIANCE

The program was found to be in noncompliance with the following licensure requirement.

155.21(8) Personnel*

- F. Personnel was in noncompliance because the program did not notify the division when a certified or licensed staff member had been sanctioned or disciplined by a certifying or licensed body in writing within ten working days of being informed.
- Licensee has been informed the program must notify the division in writing within ten working days of being informed a certified or licensed staff member had been sanctioned or disciplined by certifying or licensed body, and the notification must include the sanction or discipline order. The department was not notified within 10 working days of a staff member whose IADC was permanently revoked on March 13, 2024.
