## **Title I (Youth)**

### Eligibility

#### **In School Youth**

Individuals who are:

- Between ages 14-21
- Attending school (Sec or Post Sec)
- Low income
- Have additional barriers

#### **Out of School Youth**

Individuals who are:

- Between ages 16-24
- Not attending any school
- Have additional barriers

- Alt. school or dropout recovery services
- Experiential learning

## **Title I (Adult)**

### Eligibility

Adults 18 years of age or older who are:

- U.S. citizens, permanent resident, or alien/refugee lawfully admitted to the U.S.
- Registered with selective service, if applicable

Priority is granted for:

- Veterans and eligible spouses
- Recipients of public assistance

## **Title I (Dislocated Worker)**

### Eligibility

Adults 18 years of age or older who are:

- U.S. citizens, permanent resident, or alien/refugee lawfully admitted to the U.S.
- Registered with selective service, if applicable

- Have been terminated or laid off and is eligible for, or has exhausted, unemployment insurance benefits
- Displaced homemaker
- Self-employed but unemployed due to economic conditions

## Adult Education and Literacy

### Eligibility

Individuals 17 or older who also need one of the following:

- A high school diploma
- Basic skills instruction in math, reading, writing, computer literacy, or financial literacy (Below 9th grade)
- English language instruction and skills improvement

### Services

- High school equivalency diploma preparation and testing
- Basic skills instruction in math, reading, writing, computer literacy, and financial literacy

- English as a Second Language (ESL) instruction (within existing classes or on an as-needed basis for local businesses)
  - Tutoring for low-literacy individuals (one-on-one basis)
  - College readiness training
