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Pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code Sections 17A.18, 147A.7, and Iowa Administrative Code (I.A.C.) 641—131.7, the Iowa Department of Public Health is proposing to **REVOKE** your emergency medical care provider certification identified above.

The Department may revoke an emergency medical care provider certification when it finds that the certificate holder has committed any of the following acts or offenses:


*Failure to comply with the terms of a department order or the terms of a settlement agreement or settlement order.
IAC 641—131.7(3)i*

The following events have lead to this notice:

On June 12, 2015, the Department suspended your certification for a period of six months. The terms of the suspension required you to complete six hours of continuing education in ethics and three hours of continuing education in the area of assessment and treatment of mental health issues. As of the dates of this notice, you have failed to complete any of the required continuing education.

You have the right to request a hearing concerning this notice of disciplinary action. A request for a hearing must be submitted in writing to the Department by certified mail, return receipt requested, within twenty (20) days of receipt of this Notice of Proposed Action. The written request must be submitted to the Iowa Department of Public Health, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, Lucas State Office Building, 321 East 12th Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50319. If the request is made within the twenty (20) day time limit, the proposed action is suspended pending the outcome of the hearing. Prior to, or at the hearing, the Department may rescind the notice upon satisfaction that the reason for the action has been or will be removed.

If no request for a hearing is received within the twenty (20) day time period, the disciplinary action proposed herein shall become effective and shall be final agency action.
