



Vaccines for Adult Provider Enrollment

OVERVIEW

The Iowa Vaccines for Adults (VFA) Program is operated by the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (Iowa HHS). The VFA Program aims to increase adult vaccination rates and decrease disparities in immunization coverage by providing no-cost vaccine for uninsured or underinsured adults 19 years of age and older.

PROVIDER ELIGIBILITY

VFA vaccines are limited and will be available through the Local Public Health Agencies only. To participate in the VFA program, providers must:

- Be a local public health agency
- Have the capacity to serve as a safety net for uninsured and underinsured adults
- Be enrolled in the Iowa Immunization Registry (IRIS) and
- Agree to comply with requirements outlined in the VFA Provider Agreement and VFA Operations Guide

ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants must complete the VFA Provider Agreement and submit the online form to enroll in the program.

To save the VFA Provider Agreement and share the form to collect signatures:

- The form may be saved and returned to anytime during the submission process
- Select the save button on the bottom right of the form
- Copy and save the form link or send the link via email. This unique link is needed to re-access the saved form and may be shared with others as necessary to collect signatures

To submit the enrollment form:

- Select the submit button on the bottom left
- Upon submission, a confirmation email will be sent to the email address provided by the individual completing the form
