This chapter sets process standards and guidelines for determining parent income.

The benefit is being achieved by Child Support Services following process standards to calculate child support obligation amounts according to the Supreme Court Guidelines for various case processes such as establishing support, modifying support, and license sanction payment agreements. CSS used the Guidelines to calculate 6,094 obligation amounts in SFY24, which may not include all uses of the Guidelines for all processes during SFY24.
