The Department has considered making the changes to Iowa Code section 730.5 (7) "f:"

All confirmatory drug testing shall be conducted at a laboratory certified by the United States department of health and human services' substance abuse and mental health services administration or approved under rules adopted by the department of health and human services accreditation for forensic drug testing under the College of American Pathologists.

This change to the Code would eliminate the need for the rule.
