



Iowa Department of Health and Human Services Document Filename Suffix Chart

The table below outlines the various suffixes appended to the filename of a form, Comm, or Reference Card to note any language or legibility version difference – e.g., the PDF of Comm. 123 would be named **Comm123.pdf**, a Spanish version Comm. 123 would be named **Comm123S.pdf**, and the Large Print version of a French version of Comm. 123 would be named **Comm123FLP.pdf**.

For the official designation of the document in footers and references in text, each suffix should be separated by parentheticals – e.g. **Comm. 123(F)(LP)**.
