

Hearing Aids Success Story



Through tears after the audiologist placed the refurbished hearing aids, the member shared,

The situation/issue:

Over the last year, a member of a Senior Center had stopped attending social functions specifically due to the embarrassment of not hearing what was happening around her.



What did Wellpoint do to help:

The member's case manager was able to receive:

- A donation of hearing aids
- •\$200 toward a hearing exam through the local Lion's Club
- Milestones Area Agency on Aging donation to cover the remaining \$125 of the hearing exam
 Access2Care for transportation



What positive health and quality of life outcomes resulted from the assistance:

She can now attend social functions again and communicates more effectively with her Home Health Care provider, neighbors, Assisted Living manager, CBCM, medical providers, and the community.

Highlights

Wheelchair Ramp Success Story



ILOS are assisting with securing a ramp allowing the member to leave her home safely.



The situation/issue:

Member with diabetes suffering from a complete traumatic amputation of her left lower leg, CAD, and depression is wheelchair bound and unable to get in and out of her home without a ramp.



What did Wellpoint do to help:

The member's case manager assisted with an application for waiver services and completing a Priority Needs Assessment. A referral was also made to the In Lieu of Services (ILOS) program.



What positive health and quality of life outcomes resulted from the assistance:

The member was approved for the In Lieu of Services (ILOS) program and is waiting to get on waiver services.
