
Wellpoint CHAMP Housing Stability Initiative



CHAMP -- from Pilot to Full Initiative

- CHAMP <u>Changing Health: Amerigroup-</u> <u>Monroe Elementary School Partnership</u>
- Highlights Integrated Case Management Capabilities
- Focuses on a Defined Geographic Areas
- Utilizes Community-Based Organization Partnerships
- Works Toward Better Member Health Outcomes
- Produces Measurable Results
- Is capable of being Replicated and Scaled





CHAMP Housing Stability & Homelessness Diversion Fund

- Funds used for rental application fees, pay partial rent, utility bills of connection fees, temporary transportation assistance, automobile repairs, purchase beds and linens.
- Pilot year Goal: Assist up to 50 Wellpoint Iowa members who are in crisis.
- Actual Results: 124 Wellpoint Iowa members assisted in 2020
- 56% of participants received housing support
- 34% of participants received essential household goods
- Transportation support is the third most common need.





• Scaling the Housing Stability Initiative — The Health of Humanity Value proposition: Our competitors do not have housing or homelessness diversion initiatives

- Partnership started with 4 Community-based organizations in 4 counties in the fall 2020
- Added 17 counties in 2021
- Increased CBO participation in Findhelp.org Community Resource Link
- Now in 23 Counties
 - Black Hawk, Bremer, Cerro Gordo, Clinton, Dallas, Des Moines, Dubuque, Emmet, Jasper, Johnson, Lee, Linn, Marshall, Montgomery, Muscatine, Polk, Pottawattamie, Scott, Story, Tama, Wapello, Webster, Woodbury
 - Company funding approved to expand CHAMP in 2024
- More than 930 Wellpoint members have avoided eviction or transitioned from homelessness to safe, affordable housing.
- 100% members engaged in CHAMP complete a Health Risk Assessment
- 100% members engaged in CHAMP receive case management support
- Referral to CHAMP come from completed HRAs, providers of all types, community-base organizations, schools, faith-based organization, case managers and self-referrals.

Eligible members will receive an allowance to purchase personal care and hygiene products from an online store. Items available for selection may include:

- toothbrush/toothpaste/floss
- shampoo/conditioner
- hair combs/hair brushes
- Body wash
- lotions
- footcare products
- deodorants
- feminine products


Program Information


