## Why is this happening?

- During research completed through the Hope and Opportunities in Many Environments (HOME) project, Iowans expressed a desire to have a more uniform assessment across the Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Waivers.
- Supports Intensity Scale (SIS), will be discontinued on December 31, 2024.
- Iowa HHS will begin using assessment tools developed by interRAI effective January 1, 2025.



# What is the interRAI assessment tool?

- interRAI assessment tools are used to learn about people's needs and well-being.
- These tools are used to
  - Determine if individuals meet the clinical eligibility for the waiver.
  - Guide the planning for services and supports.
- These tools are proven to work well for people using home and community-based services.



## New Assessment Tools by Age Group

Assessment tools are specific to different age groups

#### **Ages 0-3**

No changes. Will continue using Case Management Comprehensive Functional Assessment Tool

#### Ages 4-18

Will use the interRAI Children and Youth Mental Health Assessment – Developmental Disabilities. Ages 19+

Will use the interRAI Intellectual Disability Assessment.
