#### Rule Writing Philosophy

#### Minimize Service Disruption!

#### Minimum Necessary

 Rely upon contract, state plans, individual service plans where possible

#### Clean Slate

- Not restricted by what currently exists
- Create what we need rather than shoehorning new concepts into old language

New	30     days from request     of support (No change)	7 days to referral for service	<ul> <li>No distance standard (could be virtual, in person, etc.)</li> <li>Receive contact w/i 10 days of initial request (no change)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Same access standards for providers</li> <li>No longer specified in disability services rules</li> <li>Will be in Medicaid provider manuals and communicated via informational letter</li> </ul>
