

Law Enforcement Guide to Consumable Hemp Products

This guide is provided to Law Enforcement agencies to distinguish between compliant and non-compliant Consumable Hemp products in Iowa.

Non-Compliant products in lowa

- Products intended for inhalation (e.g., hemp vape cartridges, cigarettes, cigars, pre-rolls);
- Products containing synthetic or semi-synthetic derived cannabinoids, such as Delta-6 THC, Delta-8 THC, Delta-10 THC, Delta-11 THC, HHC, THC-P, THC-O, THC-H, THC-JD, etc.;
- Products exceeding 4mg total THC per serving and/or 10mg total THC per container;
- Raw flower or bud, often labeled as THCa flower
- Adulterated products; consumable hemp products combined with amanita muscaria, muscimol, kratom, etc.;
- Products containing a total THC (inclusive of any isomers, derivatives, and analogs, whether naturally occurring or synthesized) greater than 0.3% (dry weight); or
- Any liquid hemp product less than 12 fluid ounces.

Compliant products in lowa

- Edibles containing no more than 4 mg THC (Delta-9 THC or THCa);
- Beverages with no more than 4 mg THC (Delta-9 THC or THCa) per 12 fluid ounces, with a minimum of 12 fluid ounces per container. Not to exceed 10 mg per container;
- Products that do not contain any THC (such as CBD, CBG, CBN, etc.) are not limited in serving or container size; and
- Lipid based tinctures containing less than 12 fluid ounces that do not exceed 10mg total THC.

Examples of non-compliant products:

THCa flower is often marked as "not for human consumption," however, it exceeds 0.3% TOTAL THC.



Hemp vapes (whether THC or CBD, or synthetic) are prohibited.



Syrup-like "shooter" products do not meet the minimum servings size of 12 ounces for liquids. This product also exceeds the 4 mg per 12 fluid ounce limitation.





This example is considered adulterated due to the muscimol. This product also exceeds maximum per serving and per container limits.



These products are examples of prohibited synthetic cannabinoids.





Edible products that exceed 4mg total THC serving limit and 10mg total THC container limit are non-compliant.
