

Health Stakeholders

- Share Iowa HHS fact sheets, posters, brochures and other resources with local providers, community centers, schools, etc.
- Keep your websites, newsletters and social media updated; post timely information to boost engagement.
- Partner with service groups to offer mobile clinics to make vaccines more accessible.
- Host educational events like open houses, community coffees and lunchand-learns; present for local groups.
- Engage with local media; use Iowa HHS press release templates for outreach. Review tips for <u>Managing False Balance</u> before media interactions.

Hospitals and Healthcare Providers

- Proactively educate about the risks of disease and the benefits of vaccination.
- Invite patients and caregivers to ask questions to provide informed answers.
- Review the <u>CDC-recommended</u> vaccine schedules during visits.
- Use phone, text and email to remind patients about upcoming or due vaccinations.
