Regaining Confidence, **Rejoining Community** 



#### Challenges facing our member:

Amara\* had been sleeping in the car with her two children. Primary Home Care was able to assist her with getting employment and finding an apartment, but she still needed additional assistance with monthly rent and the deposit.



#### How Wellpoint intervened:

Amara's Community Based Case Manager (CBCM) assisted her with a CHAMP application that would provide funding for the deposit for her new stable housing opportunity.



#### Outcomes supported by our involvement:

CHAMP provided the deposit and the first month's rent for Amara allowing her family to no longer live out of their vehicle and to have safe, secure, and stable housing.

#### Challenges facing our member:

Maya<sup>\*</sup> was pregnant and working with a OB Case Manager to help manage her high-risk pregnancy.



#### How Wellpoint intervened:

- \$200 worth of baby care items including car seats, diapers, and portable cribs No-cost breast pump accessory kit and microwave sterilizer Educational materials and information on community resources for pregnancy Incentives for attendance of prenatal and postpartum checkups
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#### Outcomes supported by our involvement:

Maya's Case Manager assisted with getting her updated hearing aids and pregnancy Value-Added Benefits:

Maya gave birth safely to a healthy, full-term baby girl at 39.2 weeks via primary C-section. By the end of her services with her OB Case Manager, she graduated with her associate's degree and attained new employment as a Job Coach with First Resources after previously being employed with Subway.
