Eligibility Team Updates

Our team is currently working with CMS to finalize changes that extend postpartum coverage and adjust income limits for pregnant women and infants. We are also creating training materials to help staff understand a new process for determining asset eligibility. More to come soon!

LTSS Updates

The LTSS team is excited about the release of HCBS ARPA funds to eligible providers. These funds will play a critical role in strengthening services and improving outcomes for individuals receiving care.

Iowa REACH Committee

The Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is announcing the formation of the Iowa REACH Initiative Implementation Team. This collaborative governance structure will oversee and coordinate the implementation of commitments outlined in the court-approved agreement for *C.A. v. Garcia* (case number 4:23-cv-00009-SHL-HCA).



The Implementation Team and its subcommittees will follow the core values of the Interim Settlement Agreement, emphasizing child-focused, family-driven care. Their work will prioritize collaboration across agencies, strengthen community-based supports, and ensure services are inclusive, culturally relevant, and tailored to each family's strengths.

Through these efforts, Iowa HHS aims to create a more responsive and supportive system for Iowa's youth and families.

The Delta Dental of Iowa Foundation recently provided \$450,000 to support Dental Connections and their Smile Squad mobile dental clinic program to replace their aging mobile clinic.



A “Floss-Cutting” was held in early October to celebrate the new mobile along with Des Moines Public Schools. As a community-based dentistry program, the Dental Connections Smile Squad eliminates transportation barriers by delivering dental care directly to those in need. While the priority will continue to be serving children and adults in the Des Moines metro, this new state-of-the-art mobile unit will allow the program to expand services with new partners to reach more individuals both locally and in rural areas across the state.

Wellpoint

The Wellpoint CHAMP Housing Stability Initiative has reached a significant milestone, successfully assisting over **1,100 Wellpoint members** in securing stable and affordable housing.


Since launching in 2020, we have partnered with Wellpoint Behavioral Health, Physical Health, and Long-Term Services and Supports case management programs across **23 counties**. The CHAMP Housing Initiative utilizes flexible funding to bridge the gaps left by federal, state, or county housing programs. The innovative approach has provided temporary housing, housing transition support, and specialized assistance to vulnerable groups, including adults moving to waiver homes, youth transitioning from foster care, and individuals recovering from hospital stays.

Through collaboration with community partners such as the Iowa Community Action Association, YWCA of Clinton, and Open Door Housing Services, Wellpoint CHAMP has made a profound impact. This milestone reflects the initiative's commitment to creating lasting change and ensuring that no one in the community is left without a place to call home.
