Steering Committee Objectives

- Advise and provide recommendations to HHS in the development of the MPA.
- 2. Review proposed Goals to focus and guide workgroup efforts.
- 3. Review data on projected change in the number of older individuals in the State; incorporate how such change may affect individuals with greatest economic need and greatest social need.
- 4. Review and give input on how the change in the number of individuals aged 85 and older in the State is expected to affect the need for supportive services.

Objectives cont'd

- 5. Review and give input on the programs, policies, and services provided by the State can be improved, including coordinating with area agencies on aging, and how resource levels can be adjusted to meet the needs of the changing population of older individuals in the State.
- 6. Review and give input on Workgroup action plans and proposed strategies and initiatives to include within the MPA.
- 7. Monitor and assess progress on achievement of MPA Goals, Objectives, Strategies, and Measures.
- 8. Evaluate effectiveness and impact of strategies on populations of focus and propose adjustments as needed.
