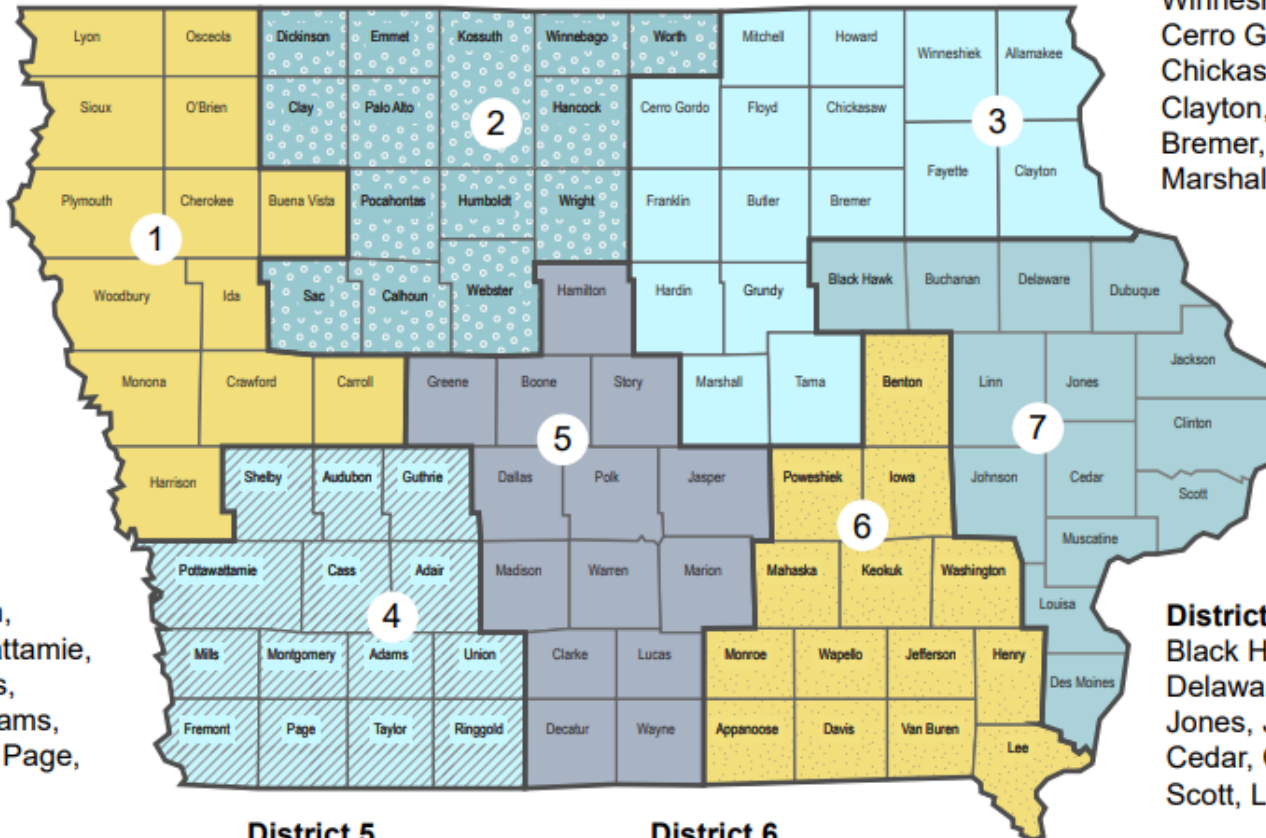

Safety Net Management Information System (SNMIS)

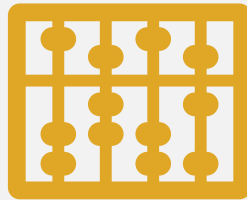
What is it?

- Claims payment system for safety net services for both Behavioral Health and Disability Services.
- Works like fee-for-service Medicaid claims payment system but, used for fee schedule payments for safety net services.

Who will use it?

- Billable services only.
- Medicaid Enrolled Providers in good standing.
- Able to submit electronic claims and accept electronic payment.

Continuity of Care

Current services and supports will remain in place through the initial implementation.

If someone gets Service Coordination from a MHDS Region, DAP staff will reach out to them and their team in May and June about the transition.

If LTSS services are authorized for individuals today, Iowa HHS and DAPs will honor service payments through transition period.
