

# Early Childhood Continuum of Care Grant

The Early Childhood Continuum of Care Grant will be awarded to Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program (SWVPP) and licensed child care center partnerships and can be used for two purposes: staff wages and transportation. Staff wages includes positions required to maintain staffing ratios and staff used to transport children to and from facilities. Examples of approved partnerships are below.

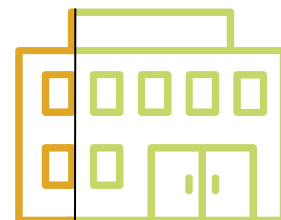
**Example 2:** SWVPP 2 and Licensed Child Care Center 2 are owned and operated **separately**, but Licensed Child Care Center 2 rents space in the building owned by SWVPP 2.

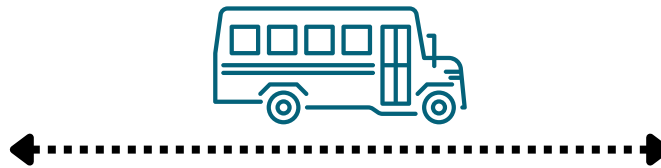
