

Quick Facts:


- Providing health coverage to children and families in Iowa with incomes too high to qualify for Medicaid.
- Children up to the age of their 19th birthday
- Whose families' income falls between 167 -302% FPL and are not eligible for lowa Medicaid and have no other insurance.



The Healthy and Well Kids in Iowa (Hawki) insurance program is Iowa's part of the federal Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

- ► This federal/state partnership provides critical medical and dental health care coverage to children who don't qualify for traditional Medicaid.
- Outreach activities are administered through a partnership between lowa Medicaid and lowa HHS.



Rate of uninsured children under 19.






Uninsured Children in Iowa



Hawki Enrollment






Hawki Outreach Coordinators




Hawki Map for CSA's



Hawki Outreach Coordinators

- ► Hawki Outreach Coordinator(s) are the <u>connection point</u> to the local community and its resources, particularly in serving the highest need areas and underserved and uninsured populations.
- ► Hawki Outreach Coordinators focus outreach with specific populations of schools, populations with limited access to healthcare services, employees without access to employer-sponsored health insurance, and other sectors.
- Hawki Outreach Coordinator(s) or HOC build and <u>strengthen local</u> <u>infrastructure</u> through local partnership development, engagement, promotion, and distribution of Hawki materials.
