- ► Target date of implementing work requirements April 1, 2026.

Waitlists

- ► Preparation of transition materials to deliver all final policy decisions and supporting documentation by June 2025.
- ► Finalizing the future state process map to illustrate updated workflows and system support related to the waitlist.
- ► Drafting memos with recommendations for future communications regarding the waitlist.



Assessments

- ► Iowa HHS is streamlining the assessment process to enhance consistency, simplicity, and person-centeredness. Two key changes took effect in 2025:
 - 1. Telligen now conducts all HCBS assessments; managed care organizations are no longer responsible for completing them.
 - 2. Individuals enrolled in the ID Waiver are now receiving InterRAI assessments, following the discontinuation of the previous tool.

► Publishing updates to the Iowa HHS assessment website in response to stakeholder feedback.



Quality

- Quality Management System (QMS) development through:
 - Building beneficiary journey maps (six developed to date) and identifying derived quality measures.
 - Developing and implementing a decision aid to help determine next steps for derived measures that overlap with or closely resemble existing performance measures.
