

Open Door Mission Health Fair

On **July 15th**, MCNA's Member Advocates and Outreach Specialist will attend the Open Door Mission Health Fair held in Omaha, to help further the Mission of this important community partner and **break the cycle of homelessness and poverty**.



- MCNA's member advocates will connect directly with our members at the health fair to assist them with eliminating social determinants of health that may be preventing them from achieving and maintaining good oral health and seeking routine dental care.
- MCNA's member advocates will also assist our most fragile members by connecting them with our highly skilled case managers who will assist them throughout their treatment plan, including addressing barriers to care.

 Our member advocates will be onsite with giveaways and oral health educational materials and will assist members with coordinating needed oral health care.

Summer Food Programs

- MCNA recognizes that summertime can be a very stressful time for our members, when the dollar must be stretched further to replace school lunches. There are many supplemental programs available to help bridge that gap this summer.
 - The Iowa Department of Education's Summer Nutrition Programs offer free meals and snacks to all children, under 18 years of age, at various locations throughout the state. Call 1-877-8-HUNGRY (English) or 1-877-8-HAMBRE (Spanish) or visit the USDA's Summer Meals for Kids Site finder to find a meal site near you.
 - Healthy Kids Iowa is a pilot program serving as an alternative to the Summer EBT program. This program offers up to \$40 per child monthly, June – August, to help provide nutritious food. Enrollment is available at participating food pantries across lowa.
