

Prepared Food Taxable vs. Non-Taxable

Cold Fried chicken - day old, was hot yesterday, now in a plastic container, sold by piece (4 piece, 8 piece), and available for purchase from a cold case. Cold Chinese food (multiple items: chicken, rice, and eggroll) - was hot yesterday, now sold in a take-out container at a static price and available for purchase from a cold case. Being sold as a "Chinese Meal". There is no self-service heating option or eating facilities on the retailer's premises.

Two or more food ingredients mixed or combined by the seller for sale as a single item.
