Driving Directions to the State Historical Building

If you're coming via **Interstate 235**, follow these steps:

- Take the East 6th Street / Pennsylvania Avenue exit.
- Head south on Pennsylvania Avenue to Grand Avenue.
- The Capitol Complex Parking Garage is located at the northwest corner of Grand and Pennsylvania—right across from the State Historical Building.

Once parked:

- Cross Grand Avenue to the museum entrance.
- Enter through the lower set of doors.
- Take the stairs or elevator to the lower level.

Additional Option: Metered parking is also available on the streets surrounding the building.
