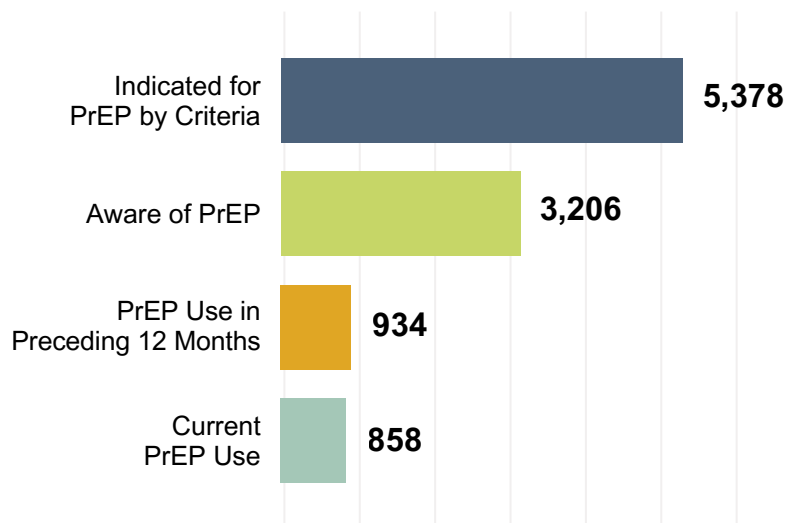


2024 HIV and Hepatitis Prevention Program Snapshot

Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Screening & Referral

ITS PrEP Awareness & Use Screening 2024



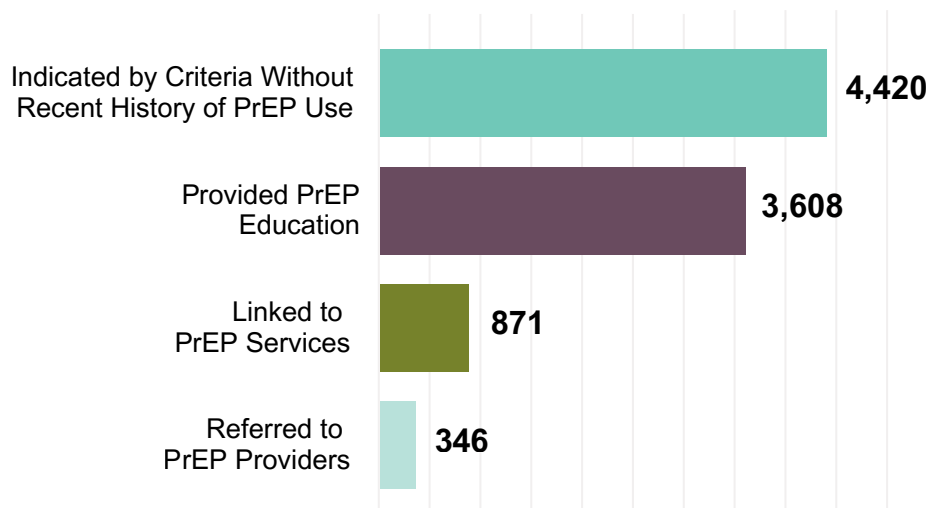
Of those who tested for HIV through Integrated Testing Services (ITS) in 2024, 5,378 met the CDC classification of indicated for PrEP HIV prevention by criteria. This classification means these populations could benefit from PrEP for HIV prevention.

- 60% of those indicated were aware of PrEP;
- 17% reported PrEP use in the preceding 12-month period; and
- 16% reported PrEP use as “current” on the date of testing.

Populations Indicated for PrEP by Criteria:

- Men who have sex with men (MSM);
- Females who have MSM partners;
- People who have been diagnosed with sexually transmitted infection in the previous five years;
- People who exchange sex for drugs, money or other things they need (and their partners);
- People who use injection drugs (and their partners); and
- People who have partners living with HIV.

PrEP Education, Linkage & Referral 2024



Among those people who were indicated for PrEP who reported no current or recent PrEP use (4,420):

- 82% received PrEP education as part of the testing encounter;
- 20% accepted linkage-to-care support; and
- 8% accepted a referral to a PrEP provider.

Data are not de-duplicated. Numbers represent test encounters not unique individuals.
