

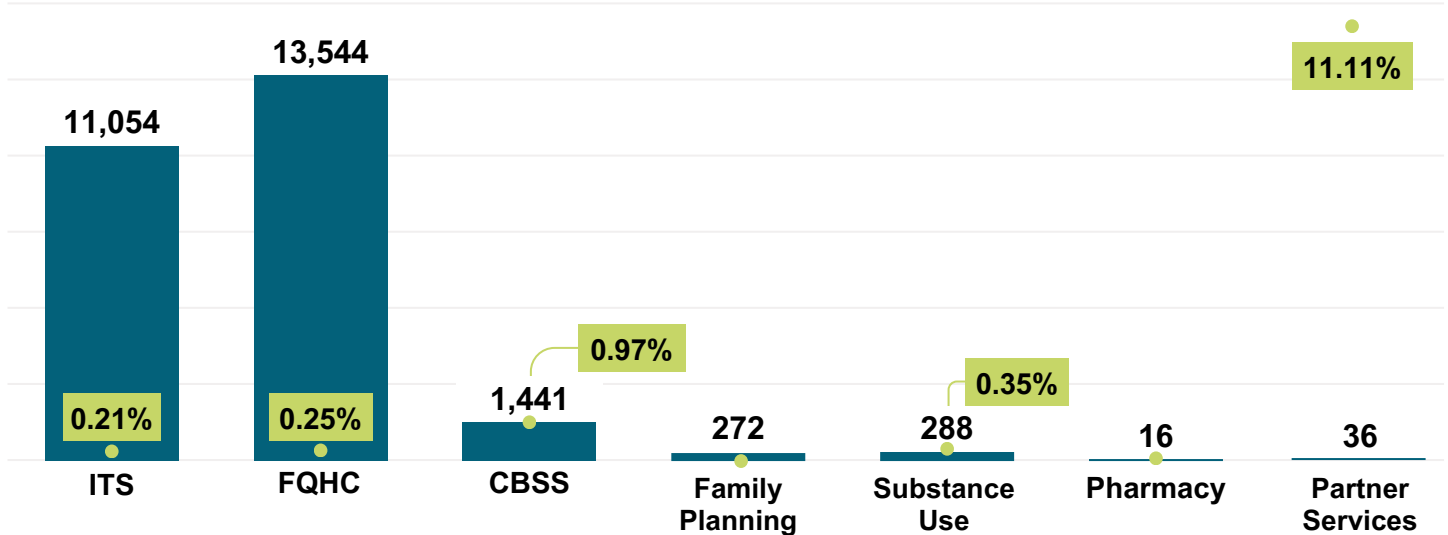
2024 HIV and Hepatitis Prevention Program Snapshot

Program-Supported HIV Screening

The HIV and Hepatitis Prevention Program partners with a variety of stakeholders to support HIV testing services across Iowa. In 2024, **26,651 rapid and conventional HIV tests** were administered in collaboration with 111 partners across eight major settings (an increase of 7% from 2023).

- **12 Integrated Testing Services (ITS)** agencies providing clinical and outreach testing
- **31 Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC)** locations working to implement routine screening across 11 agencies in partnership with the Iowa Primary Care Association
- **26 Community-based Screening Services (CBSS)** sites working with Iowa HHS to provide safety-net STI screening services
- **5 family planning clinics** providing opt-out rapid HIV screening to clients accessing STI screening services
- **14 substance use treatment locations** integrating HIV screening into medically assisted treatment programs
- **11 community-based pharmacies** providing free rapid testing in partnership with the Iowa Pharmacy Association
- **12 state disease intervention specialists** providing rapid and confirmatory HIV testing to individuals engaged in HIV partner services.

Across all projects, the program reported a 0.28% total positivity rate in 2024, a decrease from the 2023 rate of 0.35%.

State disease intervention specialists (DIS) had the highest positivity rate at 11.11%. This is likely due to the nature of partner services work, which involves active follow-up with individuals named as partners of or contacts to people newly diagnosed with HIV and other reportable sexually transmitted infections.
