


## MBQIP 2025 Timeline for Critical Access Hospitals

Starting in calendar year 2025, hospitals will collect data to report on the updated MBQIP core measures set as part of the Flex Program. Details on the new MBQIP core measure set along with those measures continuing from the MBQIP 2025 Submission Deadlines and the graphic below.

During calendar year 2024, hospitals should continue reporting the <u>existing MBQIP core measure set</u>. In addition, hospitals are encouraged to start reporting on the measures that will be new in MBQIP 2025 as soon as they are able. At a minimum, hospitals need to put processes in place so they can collect and report data from the 2025 calendar year. During this time, <u>State Flex Programs</u> and the RQITA team are available to assist hospitals and health systems with the transition.

The Federal Office of Rural Health Policy (FORHP), at the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), selected the 2025 MBQIP Core Measure Set, based on alignment with CMS and CDC national quality measure standards. This 2025 MBQIP Core Measure Set, has been adopted after a process involving FORHP staff, State Flex Programs, Critical Access Hospitals, and public comment input. Though these measures are finalized, they are always subject to change as necessary, to respond to changes in federal and state health care quality programs, as well as to support the needs of rural hospitals and the communities they serve. Details on the new MBQIP core measure set along with those measures continuing from the current MBQIP measure set are depicted in MBQIP 2025 Core Set Information Guide.
